

Online Nominations Submission by File

Transfer External Nominations

This function allows a user to submit nominations created by processes other than the Nominations Screens in the Gas Exchange System. The submitted nomination data is grouped by **pipeline**. **Note: The nominations grouping has changed. You can now submit one type of record for all nomination types.**

A web page file open dialog box will display for the user to select the fixed-length file to be processed. The program will then initiate a communication session with the Gas Exchange system and transfer the file to the Gas Exchange system for Nomination posting. The results will display for the user to review. **Note: There are no naming conventions for the file name.**

Note Field Justifications:

Numeric = Right Justified, leading spaces not required

Alpha Numeric = Right Justified, space filled

- All examples utilize ANR Pipeline – Pipeline # 5
