

EGMS Nicor Bulk Upload of Nominations by csv file


Upload Nominations

This function allows a user to submit nominations created externally from the Nominations Pages in EGMS.

From the **TPS Overview** page, selection of the following button the user to select a csv file to be processed:



will then display a web page "file open" dialog box for



The system will then initiate a communication session with EGMS and transfer the file to EGMS for Nominations posting.

Note: There are no naming conventions for the file name, except it should have a ".csv" extension: sample1.csv


EGMS will try to process the file. If there are any validations that do not pass, then those validation issues will be displayed within the EGMS page. If any one of the nominations have an issue, the whole set of nominations will not be loaded. The user will have to rectify the issues within the file, and then try to re-upload.




CSV (comma separated value) Layout

The first row in the csv contains the column header names, exactly as specified (as designated below)

All following rows will contain the nominations that are part of the bulk upload (a sample record is shown in this example):




Which would be interpreted as this:
