Install the Natural Gas Main

Beginning March 15, 2017

Nicor Gas' subcontractor, NPL, will install a new natural gas main in your neighborhood.

Install the Natural Gas Line

Beginning April 10, 2017

Nicor Gas' subcontractor, NPL, will install a new natural gas line that connects your property to the natural gas main.

Connect the System & Retire Facilities

Beginning May 1, 2017

Nicor Gas' subcontractor, United Meters, will contact you to schedule an appointment to move your natural gas meter outside and reconfigure your inside piping. Your natural gas will remain off for approximately three hours. If there is more than one meter, the process may take longer. As a safety measure, we will remove or seal the retired natural gas line at the point it enters your property.

Restore Landscaping & Pavement

Complete August 31, 2017

We understand that you value the appearance of your property. Nicor Gas will restore landscaping and paving impacted by our construction to the condition in which we found it. Temporary restoration of some areas may be necessary until permanent restoration can be completed.

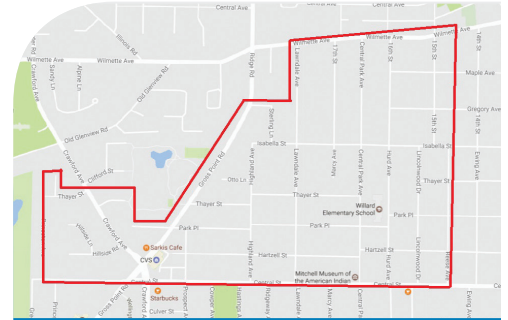

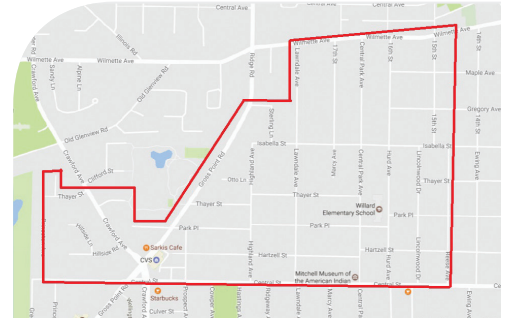
