Nicor Gas, with its contractor NPL, has been modernizing the system that delivers natural gas safely and reliably to your neighborhood and we want to keep you informed of the status of our work.

Our Progress

For the last few months Nicor Gas, with its contractor NPL, has been working to install a new natural gas main in your neighborhood. We have completed the installation of the new natural gas main and are now working on the next phase of the project which involves installing a new natural gas service line that will connect your property to the new main.

NPL began installing new service lines at Monterrey and Wildwood avenues on Wednesday, Jan. 9 and will continue installing new service lines to connect affected properties to the new main in the coming months. Utilities may again be marked with spray paint and flags during this process.

Completing Our Work: Appointment Required to Connect the System

Nicor Gas or NPL will contact you to schedule an appointment to install your service line and move your meter outside of your home if it is currently inside. Due to current weather conditions, we will not be able to connect your property to the new natural gas main without making an appointment.

If you are unable to be home during the time of this work, we ask that you please designate a family member, who is at least 18 years of age, to be present at your home so that NPL can complete this important work. Service lines that are not able to be connected during the winter months will be connected in the spring. Once the new service lines have been connected, we will begin to retire the old system.

Restore Landscaping & Pavement

We understand that you value the appearance of your property. We are utilizing temporary restoration to ensure that all areas affected by construction are safe for residents as we work to finish the project.

We anticipate this work to continue into the spring. Permanent restoration will be completed once this project is finished. We apologize for the inconvenience but please know that we are committed to restoring the street and parkway to the same or better condition than when the project started.
