to your natural gas system in Crestwood and Midlothian

Investing in Illinois: A Nicor Gas System Improvement Initiative is a multi-year initiative to modernize aging natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, will be modernizing the system that delivers natural gas safely and reliably to your neighborhood and we want to keep you informed of our work. These improvements are part of the Natural Gas Consumer, Safe-ty & Reliability Act and costs are recovered under the Qualified Infrastructure Charge. Highlighted below are the major steps involved in the project that we will soon be starting in your neighborhood.

Natural Gas Pipeline Installation

Beginning in the spring of 2023, Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, will be installing a new 4,619-foot segment of 20-inch natural gas main along Springfield Avenue beginning south of 142nd Street to south to 147th Place, continuing west on 147th Place across Pulaski Road and then south on Pulaski Road to 148th Street. We will also install a new 524-foot segment of 6-inch natural gas main along Pulaski Road and the conjoined alley located north of 147th Street between Pulaski Road and Springfield Avenue, as outlined in green on the attached map. The installation of this new segment of gas main is the second of a multi-phase project following the installation of a new segment of main which was installed along Springfield Avenue from 135th Street south to 142nd Street. This new gas main will replace an existing 20-inch natural gas main which runs along Crawford Avenue, as outlined in red on the attached map. To ensure safe transportation conditions for residents, we will need to temporarily close portions of Springfield Avenue and select cross streets as we work to install the new gas main.

Detour signage will be placed throughout the affected areas to guide traffic along alternative routes as necessary. Once the new natural gas main has been installed, we will connect it to our natural gas distribution system and bring it into service. Once each of the new segments of natural gas main has been installed along Springfield Avenue and brought into service, we will begin to retire the old 20-inch natural gas main along Crawford Avenue.

Restore Landscaping and Pavement

We understand that you value the appearance of your property. Nicor Gas, or one of its contractors, will restore landscaping and paving impacted by our construction to the condition in which we found it. Temporary restoration of some areas may be necessary until permanent restoration can be completed.

We sincerely appreciate your patience as we modernize and improve our natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas is working closely with community leaders to reduce the impact this work has on local roads and other pathways.


For Your Safety
