Investing in Illinois: A Nicor Gas System Improvement Initiative is a multi-year initiative to modernize aging natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, has been working to modernize the system that delivers natural gas safely and reliably to your neighborhood and we want to keep you informed of the status of our work.

Our Progress

Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, has been working to install a new 4,600-foot segment of 20-inch natural gas main along Springfield Avenue from 135th Street, south to 142nd Street. We have completed the installation of a portion of the new gas main from south of 135th Street to 139th Street, as outlined in green on the attached map. Due to scheduling challenges as well as considerations for avoiding potentially disruptive construction and associated restoration work during the winter months, we have decided to halt construction for 2022 and finish installing the remaining portion of the new gas main involved in this phase of the project in the spring of 2023. We will continue our restoration work within the areas impacted by this year's construction into late October 2022 before temporarily demobilizing from the area.

Completing Our Work

Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, will return to the area in March 2023 to resume construction and finish installing the remaining portion of the new 20-inch gas main involved in this phase of the project from 139th Street south to 142nd Street, as outlined in blue on the attached map. Once the new 20-inch natural gas main has been installed along Springfield Avenue and brought into service, we will begin to retire the old 20-inch natural gas main along Crawford Avenue extending from 135th south to 142nd Street, as outlined in red on the attached map. Once we have completed the first phase of the project, Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, will proceed to the next phase of the project which will include the installation and retirement of additional segments of natural gas main from 142nd Street south to 148th Street, as outlined in purple and orange on the attached map respectively. Customers impacted by the next phase of the project will be contacted separately prior to work beginning in 2023.

Restore Landscaping & Pavement

We understand that you value the appearance of your property. Nicor Gas or one of its contractors will restore landscaping and paving impacted by our construction to the condition in which we found it. Temporary restoration of some areas may be necessary until permanent restoration can be completed. We sincerely appreciate your patience as we modernize and improve our natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas is working closely with community leaders to reduce the impact this work has on local roads and other pathways.

For Your Safety


