to your natural gas system in Robbins and Crestwood

Investing in Illinois: A Nicor Gas System Improvement Initiative is a multi-year initiative to modernize aging natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, will be modernizing the system that delivers natural gas safely and reliably to your neighborhood and we want to keep you informed of our work. These improvements are part of the Natural Gas Consumer, Safety & Reliability Act and costs are recovered under the Qualified Infrastructure Charge. Highlighted below are the major steps involved in the project that we will soon be starting in your neighborhood.

Natural Gas Pipeline Installation

Beginning in the spring of 2022, Nicor Gas, with its contractor Meade, will be installing a new 4,600-foot segment of 20-inch natural gas main along Springfield Avenue beginning south of 135th Street, continuing south to 142nd Street, as outlined in green on the attached map. This new gas main will replace an existing 20-inch natural gas main which runs along Crawford Avenue, as outlined in red on the attached map. To ensure safe transportation conditions for residents, we will need to temporarily close portions of Springfield Avenue and select cross streets as we work to install the new gas main. Detour signage will be placed throughout the affected areas to guide traffic along alternative routes as necessary. Once the new natural gas main has been installed, we will connect it to our natural gas distribution system and bring it into service.

Connect the System & Retire Facilities

Once the new 20-inch natural gas main has been installed along Springfield Avenue and brought into service, we will begin to retire the old 20-inch natural gas main along Crawford Avenue. The main which runs along Crawford Avenue currently serves a series of customers in your neighborhood directly. If your home or business is connected to the old natural gas main being retired, we will install a new service line to your home or business from a separate new natural gas main which is being installed as part of another project. After the new service line has been installed, Nicor Gas or our contractor will contact you to schedule an appointment to connect the new service line to your existing natural gas meter. Your natural gas will need to be shut off for approximately three hours as we complete this work. Customers requiring a new service line will receive a separate communication with additional details outlining this process.

Restore Landscaping & Pavement

We understand that you value the appearance of your property. Nicor Gas, or one of its contractors, will restore landscaping and paving impacted by our construction to the condition in which we found it. Temporary restoration of some areas may be necessary until permanent restoration can be completed. We sincerely appreciate your patience as we modernize and improve our natural gas infrastructure. Nicor Gas is working closely with community leaders to reduce the impact this work has on local roads and other pathways.

For Your Safety


